



## **Ballater Duck Festival 2022**

We're pleased to confirm that we're holding the annual **Ballater Duck Festival** on **Sunday 3 July 2022**. The 'get-in'/set-up will start at 09:00 (NB: no earlier), trading will start at 11:00, the Duck Race down the River Dee will be at 15:00 and the Festival will close at approximately 16:00. We had to cancel the 2020 event due to Covid restrictions and scale-down the 2021 event, so we'll be making every effort to ensure the 2022 event is as successful as it was in previous years.

We hope to have more than 50 craft, charity and trade stalls at the Festival in addition to various children's rides including a giant slide, bouncy castle, roundabout and 'hook-a-duck'. The Ballater Pipe Band plus a stage with live performances from Strathspey & Reel fiddlers and a local choir will be there to entertain us. Any profit from the event is put towards improving the infrastructure of Ballater.

If you would like to join our Festival by having a stall this year, please complete the form below. We're offering 4m x 4m pitches on one of the Greens adjacent to or opposite the church NB: no gazebo/tent or tables will be offered; it is entirely up to each stall holder to provide these. Also, when your stall/gazebo (normally 3m x 3m) is erected, please ensure that it does not encroach on neighbouring pitches. Should you require a bigger pitch than the standard 4m x 4m, please ensure you request this at the time of booking giving maximum dimensions and preferably a photo of your gazebo/tent/unit so that we can allocate you the appropriate pitch and avoid issues with your neighbours! We can offer 'double pitches' or 'adjoining pitches'; again, please specify this at the time of booking. Should you have a preference for where your pitch is to be situated, please ensure this is requested at the time of booking; the organisers will attempt to meet your request, but this cannot be guaranteed. NB: there will be no inside stalls.

Fees for each 4m x 4m pitch on the Greens is £25 for all trade or craft businesses, or £15 for charity organisations; double these amounts for larger pitches.

It is possible to advertise your business in 'The Quacker', our A5 (21cm x 15cm) colour brochure, 1000 copies of which will be distributed before and at the Duck Festival free of charge. The cost is £100 for a full page advert, £50 for a ½ page, or £25 for a ¼ page; if this is of interest to you, please send an email to me for more information or mention this on the booking form.
